Yet . . .

Scripture: Philemon

This is a our second week looking at a the letter from Paul, in prison, to Philemon, leader of a house church. Paul sends it as he sends Onesimus, a runaway slave, back to Philemon urging him to receive him "no longer as a slave, but better than a slave, as a dear brother."
